We are planning to promote Domestic Abuse Awareness around white ribbon day, last year we had an open event that was great but for obvious reasons we are unable to do that this year.

Therefore, our plan this year is a social media event raising awareness of domestic abuse especially through COVID-19 and to promote our services and get the word out locally that we are still here and can offer safety, support and advice to women and children. We will be holding 'Duck Race' to raise funds and a Christmas raffle. We are also in the process of setting up an Amazon 'wish list' for donations and we are also a listed charity on Amazon Smile, both of which we will be promoting during the campaign.
