Observer Tickets for the NFWI Annual Meeting are now on sale.

The NFWI Annual Meeting is on 8th June 2021 from 10.30am to 4.30pm.

It is on a bespoke virtual event platform and will include exhibitors stands and breakout rooms.

There is no upper limit to the number of tickets available for Observers.

Observer tickets are **£9 each** (including booking fees) and one ticket covers one device i.e., one mobile, one laptop, one iPad, **or** one desktop PC etc. and cannot be used on multiple devices simultaneously. There is no limit to the number of people viewing each device (apart from the Covid regulations in place at the time of the meeting) so why not get a group of you together to make a day of it.

Ticket sales are available **to 1st June 2021**

This year members have to register for a ticket themselves as they are not available via the Federation Office
